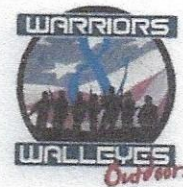

Notice of Service Line Materials

Inventory Accessibility

The City of Wood Lake has completed and submitted our service line materials inventory to the Minnesota Department of Health. The service line inventory is publicly available, and you can check the materials for your service line by visiting the Lead Inventory Tracking Tool (LITT) (<https://maps.umn.edu/LSL/>) you may also contact us at 507.485.3476 or woodlake@redred.com. To complete the service line inventory our system conducted direct visual observation of service line pipes at the point of entry into buildings, reviewing construction plans and specifications for prior projects, reviewing installation records and building codes, and resident survey self-reporting. As of 10/16/2024 our inventory contains 0 lead, 1 galvanized requiring replacement, 132 unknown material, and 79 non-lead service lines.
