

Attention Wood Lake Residents:

Effective January 1, 2025, the City of Wood Lake/Public Works has decided to implement a Utility Access Fee. At a Special Meeting of the Wood Lake City Council, held on August 26, 2024, City Council voted in favor of a \$20.00 Utility Access Fee. This fee is applicable to any new or existing residents that have a meter and/or water shutoff valve in the City of Wood Lake. This is a fee charged to the resident for having Public Works access and/or replace the meter on their property due to negligent circumstances, and/or to reconnect utility services that had been previously shut-off. In the situation that your utility services have been shut-off by the City due to non-payment, the \$20.00 Utility Access Fee is to be paid in full to the City Clerk before utility services are re-instated.
